This monthly meeting was called to order at 7:05 pm at the King County Sheriff's Office – Fairwood Storefront.

Fire Department Report: There was no Fire Department Report this month

Police Report: There was no Police Department Report this month

Approval of Last Month's Minutes: The last month's minutes were approved.

Homeowner Concerns: There were no homeowners issues brought up except for the complaint that has been open for some time about a homeowner who installed an extremely tall shed. The footprint of the shed was approved but the height was not documented on the request.

Committee Reports:

Common Areas Maintenance Report:

- Reminder to all Homeowners It is our responsibility (Not King County's) to keep the street drains clear. Please clear the debris and leaves from the drains by your house and at the ends of your street.
- We continue to have branches and trees fall onto the paths at CR Park. Please contact me at commonareas@crcwhoa.org or call 425-738-8611 and leave a message if you notice any trees or branches at

either park or any of the Common areas or entrances.

- At Candlewood Ridge along 159 Ave. SE we had a 65 ft Douglas Fir tree fall in that big windstorm we had at the beginning of March. It fell directly across the entire street, King County Roads cut it up and cleaned the street. The only damage was to the streetlight.
- Reminder all dogs must be on leash this is a King County Law as well as our policy in our HOA. Also PLEASE use the provided Mutt Mitts and pick up after your dogs. Many thanks to you polite Dog Owners that do pick up after your dogs.
- We have had more problems with the Basketball Hoop and the Shed. The adjusting tool went missing, both locks are gone, and the shed has been damaged again. Somebody gave the combo out or left the locks off and the group of 'Out of area' teens were seen using the Basketball Court. The adjusting tool has since been turned in by a Homeowner's Son who was forced off the Court by these teens. We are going to lock up the hoop and shed with keyed locks and they will remain locked until a solution can be found. The Board has tried everything we could think of and are asking the Homeowners who want to use this Court to form a committee and come up with solutions. Please contactpresident@crcwhoa.org.

- Someone has graffitied the storage shed at CW Park; we will have to probably paint over it when the weather gets a bit warmer.
- King County Sheriff Patrols and requests will now be coordinated by the CAM Chair and monthly reports will be submitted before each monthly meeting. Please contact the Board with any areas of concern and we will do our best to accommodate.
- Please keep a watch for suspicious Activity and call 911
- **Reminder:** Our parks are private parks which exist for the use and enjoyment of HOA residents, their families and guests. They are not public parks. Our park usage rules apply to everyone. Following are some of the rules that have been established to maximize safety, and minimize liability and maintenance cost:
- A. Park Hours: 9:00 am to dusk.
- B. No Smoking, alcohol, drugs, loud music, golfing, motorized vehicles or **Fireworks** are allowed.
- C. Animals must be leashed, and owners are responsible for cleaning up after their animals.

ACC Report:

We accept ACR requests via e-mail when the form does not need paint chips. (All paint chips must be mailed or hand delivered.) It has been noted that paint requests have been received lately without paint chips as well as requests without ACR forms. All requests must be accompanied by ACR forms which must be <u>signed</u>, include a valid address and phone number and, if for paint or stain, must include paint chips and note which paint is for what part of the house (body, trim, deck, gutters, door, ...). If you want to speed up your notification, be sure that your email address is clearly written.

- 1 driveway replacement
- 3 paint
- 1 drainage trench
- 1 chimney repair and 1 chimney removal (same hhouse)

Complaints Negotiations Report:

There were 3 complaints. Please note that the complaints mentioned in the minutes do NOT include complaints generated by the annual walk thru unless specifically noted.

Treasurer's Report:

The treasurer's report was on track

Legal and Insurance Report:

One house that has been vacant for 10 years in CR had papers filed for a sheriff's sale. However, the homeowner paid off all outstanding dues, fees and fines recently. He has not done any maintenance so we may have to refile liens as the costs continue.

Community Events Committee

We need volunteers. The Easter Egg Hunt has been cancelled due to the lack of volunteers and the COVID-19 crisis.
